

Licensure Information: Program Completers in MSD

The Linfield teacher preparation program (TEP) works closely with McMinnville School District where all Linfield TEP field experiences and most Linfield TEP student teaching placements occur. Many Linfield TEP program completers become teachers in the district. In order to track employment milestones, we decided examine the types of licenses that Linfield program completers who teach in the district hold.

- We found that 71% of Linfield-prepared teachers working In McMinnville School District have progressed from the Preliminary Teaching License to the Professional Teaching License, Principal License, or Professional Administrator License. Our graduates are continuing to develop their professional skills to advanced levels after completing the Linfield TEP.
- Of the 25 Linfield TEP program completers who hold Preliminary Teaching Licenses, 21 (84%) are in their first 10 years of teaching. We expect that most of these graduates will go on to earn Professional Teaching Licenses.
- Four graduates hold administrator licenses. One is an elementary principal, one is a high school principal, one is a former high school principal (now serving at the district office), and the fourth has served as a middle school principal and is currently a middle school assistant principal.
