

The table below identifies how credit is awarded for International Baccalaureate content areas.

- Linfield awards four credits for each Standard Level International Baccalaureate exam and eight credits for each Higher Level International Baccalaureate exam when a score of 5 or higher is earned.
- Students may count up to a total of 31 credits from Advanced Placement, International Baccalaureate, and other non-course credits towards the 125 required for graduation.
- Credits from any one IB exam may be used to fulfill only one general education area (three exceptions noted below). If an IB subject has two areas listed you can choose where you would like it to apply.
